Zoey Moldenhauer 8 years old in Grade 2 wrote a book called "The Fairy Adventure".

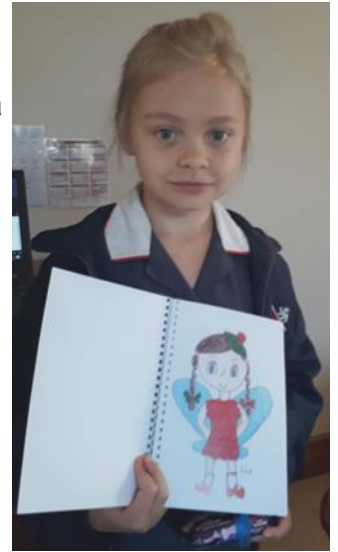


It's a story about 2 fairies Lia and Mia trying to find their parents. All the illustrations were created by Zoey with a bit of help from mom!
